

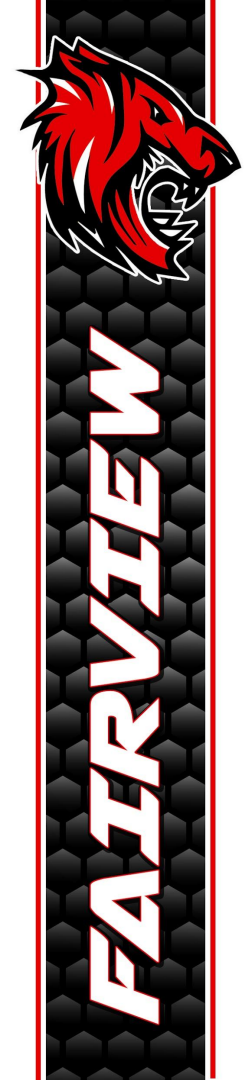

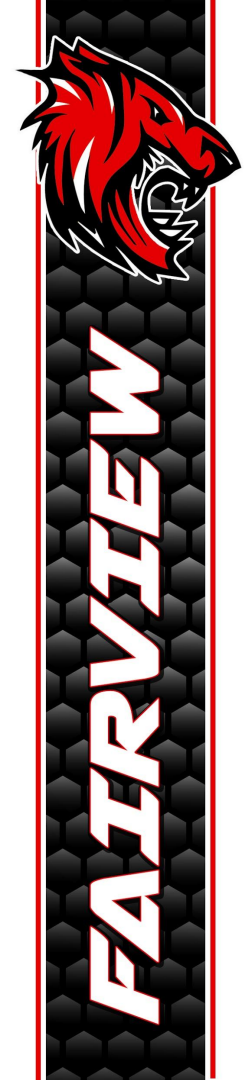
Re-Entry Options

- Option 1: K-6 in-person M-Th.
7-12 Remote/In-person Fri.
- Option 2: K-12 ABCAB Streaming
- Option 3: FES Half-day
FMS & FHS- ABCAB Streaming
- Option 4: Modified Traditional



Option 1- Approved Hybrid Plan

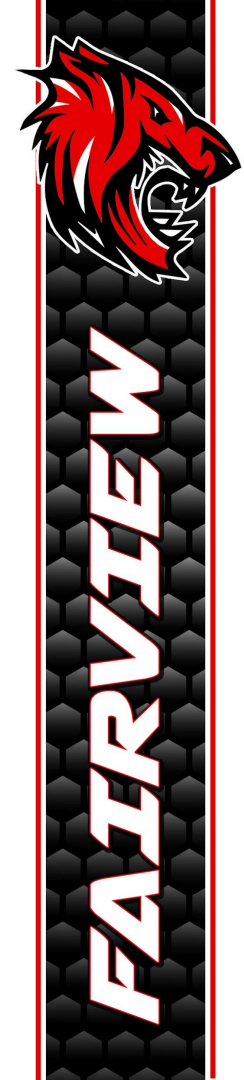
- K-6 spread throughout the district M-Th.
- 7-12 Remote M-Th. In-person Fri.



Option 1 - Approved Hybrid Plan

Advantages

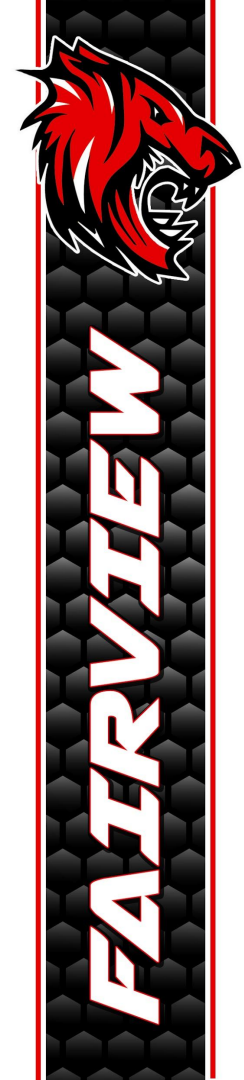
- K-6 students are face-to-face 4 days a week
- 7-12 students continue successful remote learning and attend live once per week
- Decreased overall building capacity



Option 1 - Approved Hybrid Plan

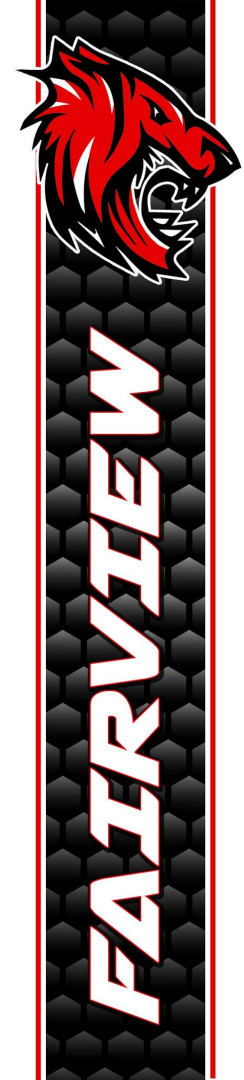
Disadvantages

- Classes at full capacity
- 7-12 students limited to one day per week
- Cannot maintain 6-foot separation
- Students and teachers displaced from respective buildings
- Does not meet CDC and DOH recommendations
- Siblings possibly on different schedules
- Transportation capacity concerns



Hybrid Option 2

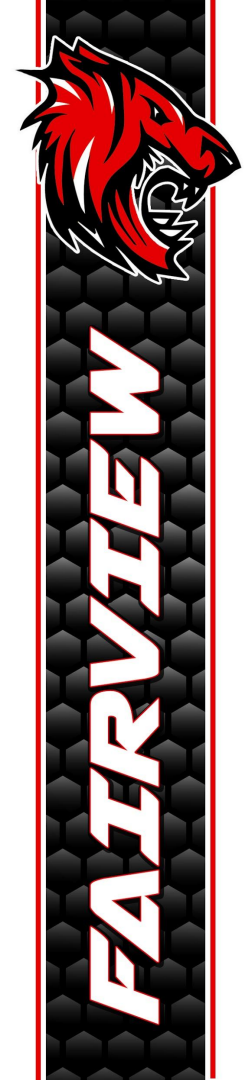
- K-12 (ABCAB) with streaming from all classrooms at FHS and FMS
*Alternate plans for FES based on enrollment.
- Begin Oct.1 through First Semester



Hybrid Option 2 (K-12 ABCAB Streaming)

Advantages

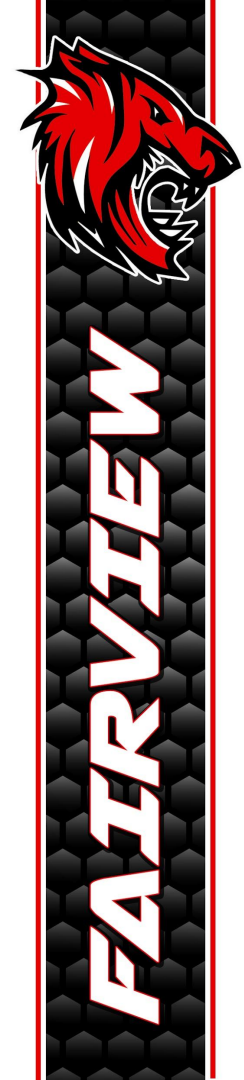
- Safety
- Equal face to face time K-12
- Consistency across the district
- Smooth transition plan
- Students and teachers stay in respective buildings
- 50% capacity in classrooms and buildings
- Parents/students have a choice
- Cyber Academy can further develop
- Transportation capacity is achievable



Hybrid Option 2 (K-12 ABCAB Streaming)

Disadvantages

- Teacher is not as accessible when student is home
- Difficulty covering 100% of curriculum
- More teacher-centered approach
- Difficult to engage all learners (especially younger)

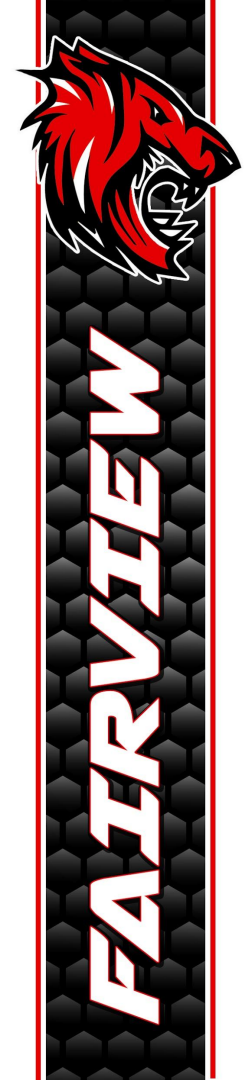

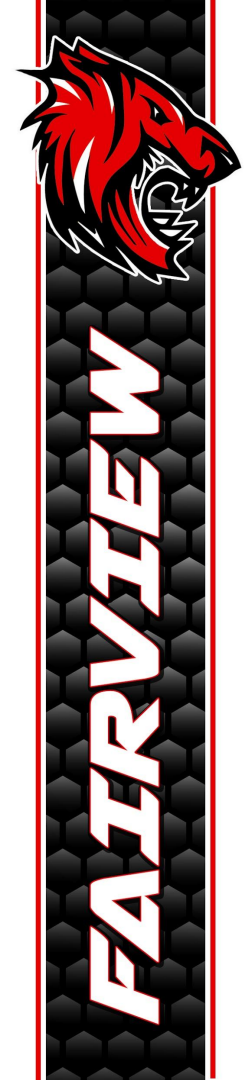

FES Schedule

8:55 - 11:45 AM Session

12:45 - 3:35 PM Session

*Students will participate in Specials classes and complete independent work opposite their in-school time.

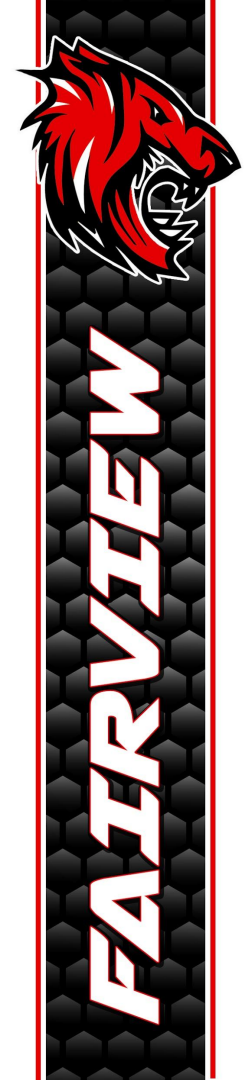


Hybrid Option 3

FES a.m/p.m., FHS/FMS ABCAB Streaming

Advantages for FES

- Safety - 50% capacity
- More face-to-face time for students (compared to ABCAB)
- Teachers see students every day
- Eliminates lunch and recess
- Students and teachers stay in respective building
- Choice for families
- Improves transportation capacity
- One mode of instruction for the teacher
- Masking is limited to ½ day for FES

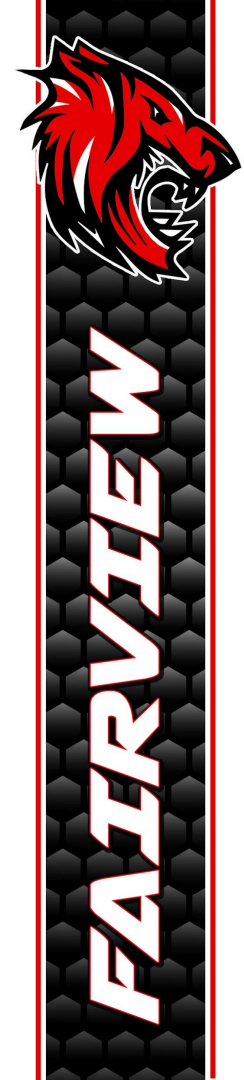


Hybrid Option 3

FES a.m/p.m., FHS/FMS ABCAB Streaming

Disadvantages for FES

- Different schedule than older siblings
- Increased bus runs
- Challenging for working families of younger students

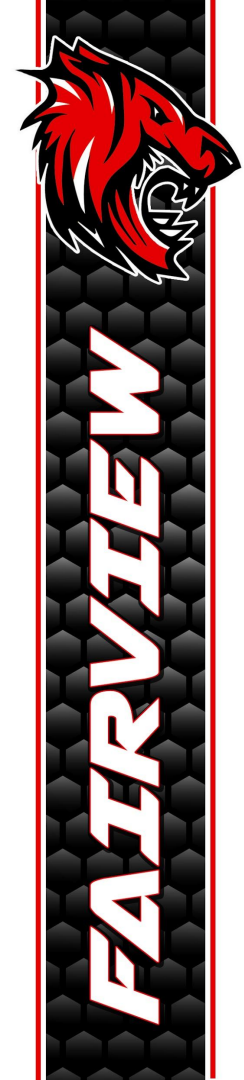


Hybrid Option 3

FES a.m/p.m., FHS/FMS ABCAB Streaming

Advantages for FMS and FHS

- 50% classroom capacity for safety due to lack of social distancing
- Affords consistent schedule through remainder of semester
- Students continue to have live, in-person responsibilities and experiences every day

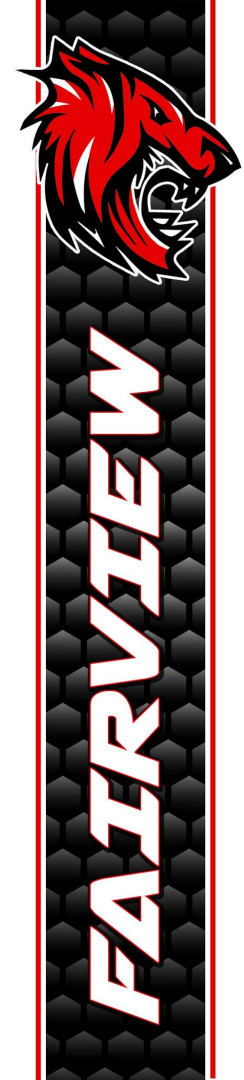


Hybrid Option 3

FES a.m/p.m., FHS/FMS ABCAB Streaming

FMS and FHS Schedule - ABCAB Streaming

- A-Day = students last names A-L
- B-Day = students last names M-Z
- C-Day = students follow Remote schedule with live check-ins each period

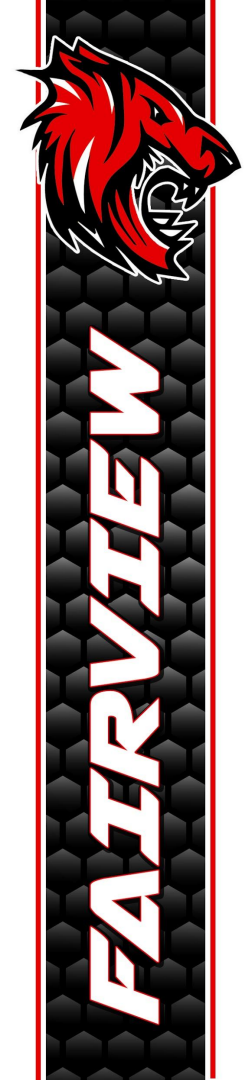


Hybrid Option 3

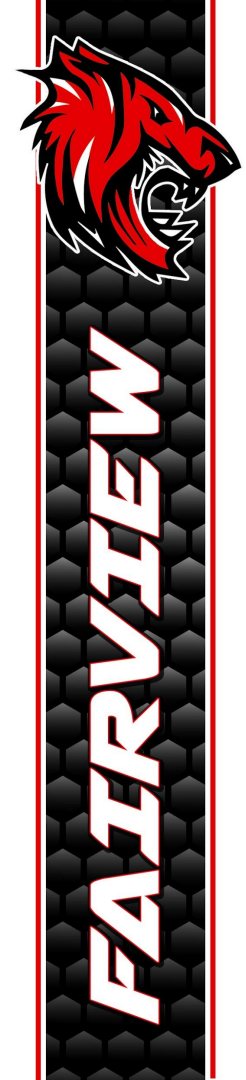
FHS Schedule - ABCAB Streaming

- Traditional daily schedule without homeroom or tutorial (to minimize exposure).
- Lunches will be socially-distanced utilizing assigned, 2-student seating in the cafeteria.
- Most classrooms will be socially distanced; students will wear masks throughout the day.



Option 4 - Modified Traditional

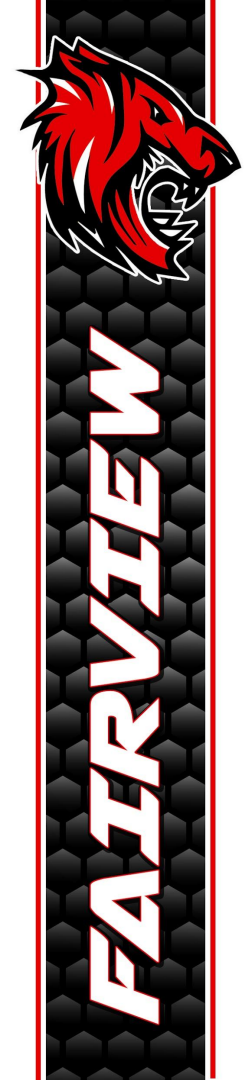
- Students return to their respective buildings at full capacity
- Live streaming would be available for those who elect to stay home
- Alternative lunch spaces will need to be explored



Option 4 - Modified Traditional

Advantages

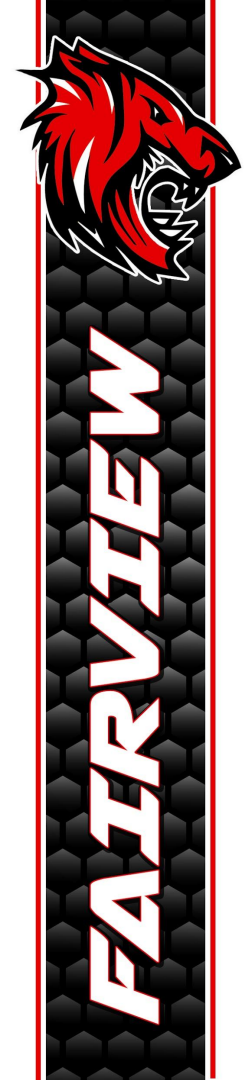
- School is back to “normal”
- Parents would have the choice of in-school or remote
- Curriculum coverage is 100%



Option 4 - Modified Traditional

Disadvantages

- Building and classrooms at full capacity
- Buses at full capacity
- Lunch/Recess limitations
- Cannot achieve 6-foot social distancing
- Large-scale quarantines in the event of a positive case
- Not recommended by the Department of Health
